CHILDREN'S RADIOTHON RAISES RECORD FUNDS FOR LOCAL AGENCIES

WBEV / WXRO CHILDREN'S RADIOTHON TAKES IN NEARLY \$130,000, toppling totals from previous years

BEAVER DAM, WI – It was a record-breaking year for the 15th Annual WBEV / WXRO Children's Radiothon. This year's preliminary total is \$129,864.94, nearly \$14,000 more than last year's final tally.

The Radiothon began at 6 a.m. on Thursday, June 21, and concluded more than 27 hours later. Money was raised through a marathon on-air auction – featuring items donated by local community members and advertising partners – and a variety of activities held throughout the region. Over the past 15 years, the Radiothon has raised more than \$1.2 million.

"The generosity of the community is astounding," says Good Karma Broadcasting President Craig Karmazin. "The Radiothon is truly a cooperative effort of our Good Karma Broadcasting teammates, marketing partners, and especially our fans that enable this event to be such a success.

"For a fourth year in a row, Noel's Angel Walk provided a huge boost to the final total. The event was organized by Lori and Scott Smith of Beaver Dam and dedicated to their late daughter Noel Ann Smith. More than 200 people walked a one-mile or 2.5-mile route on Thursday morning. In its four-years of existence, the walk has raised nearly \$60,000 for the Radiothon.

The Radiothon also featured a, dessert auction, car wash and brat fry. Local radio personalities took in more than \$5,000 in monetary donations with a fishing pole while perched on the roof of the radio station. Local motorcycle clubs will also beholding a special ride Thursday, June 28, with funds raised expected to boost this year's final total.

Plans are already underway for next year's event.
